4	Most Handsome Dog	Best looking male on the day	
5	Cutest Puppy	Best looking male or female puppy <b>6 to 18 months</b>	
6	Most appealing expression	Animal whose facial features appeal most to the judge on the day	
7	Best Trick	Animal who can do the best trick or tricks on the day	
8	Waggiest Tail	The most tail wags over a few seconds	
9	Best Biscuit Catcher	Animal who can catch best of 6 thrown biscuits	
10	Egg and Spoon Race	First dog and handler to reach finish line without dropping egg –while holding dog lead and spoon in same hand	
	<b>BEST IN SHOW</b>	The winners of all dog categories (3-10) will be considered for the best in show	

The classes will be held in the order given and will be announced by loud hailer. Entrants are responsible for presenting themselves at their events in time so listen out for the announcements. It is probably best to watch the events so that you will be in place at the right time.

If there are a lot in each category or there is a tie there may be heats or deciders.

## Rules for the Day

1. No bitches in season, please.
2. Sorry, no puppies under 6 months to avoid unnecessary stress.
3. Dogs must be kept on leads at ALL times.
4. Dog owners /handlers must clean up after their dogs. Dog waste bags are available from the Registration table. There are bins provided around the Park.
5. The safety and wellbeing of all animals at the event is the responsibility of their owners.
6. Children under 10 should be accompanied by an adult.
7. Dog owners will be responsible for any damage or harm caused to property, people or other animals made by their dog/s.
8. If the weather is really bad the dog show will be cancelled. We've usually been lucky with the weather at Tea in the Park though.
